

LYMINGTON XOD DIVISION

Allocation of Divisional Trophies 2011

Awarded annually at the Annual Dinner except where stated

ALLOTT CUP

Awarded to the helm of the XOD from either Yarmouth or Lymington Divisions scoring the least points in any six of ten specified races of the nominated events of the Royal Lymington Yacht Club, Royal Solent Yacht Club & Royal Artillery Yacht Club.

AUTUMNUS TROPHY

To the first visiting boat overall in the Autumn Series unless that boat wins the Blue Phantom Trophy, in which case the trophy shall be awarded to the first boat in the Lymington Division. The number of races to count shall be one less than the number of races completed except that all races shall count if three or fewer races are completed.

BLUE PHANTOM CUP

To the overall winner of the Autumn Series. The number of races to count shall be one less than the number of races completed. All races shall count if three or fewer races are completed.

CANDLESTICKS TROPHY

To the winner of the Long Race East.

COCK BOAT CUP

To the leading XOD in the current season's Saturday & Wednesday Series points races (but not including the Autumn Series). A minimum of 10 races must be sailed to qualify and 50% of all races sailed shall count rounded up to the nearest whole number. In the event of a tie the winner shall be that boat that has the greatest number of first, second or third placings, in that order, to resolve the final winner.

THE LAW SOCIETY TROPHY (formerly known as the Crews Cup)

To a crew member nominated by the helm winning the Cock Boat Cup.

DEAN MAIDEN CUP (Consolation Cup)

To the highest placed finisher in a nominated race sailed on a Saturday during the Autumn Series who has NOT won a first gun in any race qualifying for the Cock Boat Cup. A minimum of 10 races must be sailed to qualify.

MARRIAGE SALVER (formerly the Marriage Handicap)

To the highest placed husband and wife team sailing together in not less than 10 races qualifying for the Cock Boat Cup.

GERALD GRAY CUP

To the highest placed overall boat in XOD Week not winning any trophy in that series.

WEDNESDAY HALF POINTS CUP

To the 3rd placed boat overall in the Wednesday Points Series.

SATURDAY HALF POINTS TANKARD

To the 3rd placed boat overall in the Saturday Points Series

HELMSMAN'S CUP

To the winner of the Long Race West

HOTHAM CUP

To the overall winner of the XOD Wednesday Points Series.
Results are computed on 50% of races completed, rounded up.

JACQUIE COOPER CANDELABRA

To the person who in the opinion of the XOD Divisional Captain has done something special for the Division during the past season.

JADE CUP

To the overall winner of the Saturday Points Series.
Results are computed on 50% of races completed, rounded up.

LADIES CUP

To the highest place overall Lady Helm in the Wednesday and Saturday Points Series (ie the Cock Boat Series), the results being decided on 50% of races completed, rounded up.

L'ESCARGOT CUP

To the winner of the Wednesday Points Handicap Series, the results being decided on 50% of races completed, rounded up.

LYMINGTON XOD WEEK CUP

To the winner of the Saturday race in XOD week.

WADE CUP

To the winner of the Wednesday race in XOD Week.

MOLLYMAWK TROPHY

By the XOD Divisional Captain to the most deserving Elder Statesperson racing in the Division in that year, as a mark of admiration and esteem for a well deserved honour or achievement during the past season.

NO GUNS CUP (SATURDAY POINTS)

To the highest placed overall finisher in the Saturday Points Series not scoring a first, second or third place in any race in that series.

NO GUNS CUP (WEDNESDAY POINTS)

To the highest placed overall finisher in the Wednesday Points Series not scoring a first, second or third place in any race in that series.

PATON TROPHY

To the overall winner of the Saturday Points Handicap series, the results being decided on 50% of races completed.

PERSEPHONE SALVER (Number 1)

Awarded at the XOD Annual Dinner of the winning helm

To the winner of a joint race between Lymington and Yarmouth Divisions, held at Lymington

PERSEPHONE SALVER (Number 2)

Awarded at the XOD Annual Dinner of the winning helm

To the winner of a joint race between Lymington and Yarmouth Divisions, held at Yarmouth.

RUNNERS UP CUP (SATURDAY POINTS)

To the runner up in the Saturday Points Series.

RUNNERS UP CUP (WEDNESDAY POINTS)

To the runner up in the Wednesday Points Series.

SINGLE HANDED RACE TANKARD

To the winner of a race for XOD's sailed single handed by the owner or part owner.

Sir ARTHUR McDONALD Trophy

Awarded after race

To the winner of a race sailed in XOD's with the helm being under 18 years of age on the day of the race.

SKEDADLER TROPHY

To the winner of the Tuesday race in XOD Week.

Awarded annually to the overall winner of XOD Week.

AUTUMN SERIES SATURDAY TROPHY

To the overall winner the Autumn Saturday Series. No discards are permitted.

JEWEL JUG

To the overall winner of the Autumn Handicap Series. The number of races to count shall be one less than the number of races completed. All races shall count if three or fewer races are completed.

DUNCAN HALL TROPHY

Awarded at RLymYC Pottership prizegiving

To the first placed XOD in the Potter Ship Race.

ALASTAIR EASTON TROPHY

Awarded at event

To the winner of an Invitation Meeting comprising three Windward/Leeward races held on a Saturday in May or June of each year.

BOBBY BONGERS TROPHY

Awarded at event

To the winner of an Invitation Meeting comprising three Windward/Leeward races held on a Saturday in September of each year.

UNIMARINE TROPHY

Awarded at Thursday evening prizegiving

To the overall winner of the XOD Thursday Evening Series.
